## **Signing On and Passes**

Signing on will take place in the Secretary's Office from 08.30am – Driver and any passenger(s) must attend together to sign on. Drivers and passengers will be issued with wristbands at Signing On. These must be visible to the Start Line Marshall.

Drivers and passengers can enter and sign on at the event. Please attend the Secretary's Office if you would like to do this.

There will be no charge for spectator entrance to Blyton Park.

#### Venue and Access

<u>There is no access to Blyton Park on Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> February and no overnight camping is permitted.</u> Gates will open at 08:00 on Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> February 2023. Please do not attempt to arrive prior to this time.

# Pit and Paddock Areas – <u>Please do not park on the grass</u>

Each entrant will park in the designated paddock area.

Please ensure that you do not park across the emergency lanes or on the grass.

If you are bringing a large vehicle, please ensure you have notified the MDA in advance so that the appropriate space can be allocated.

Only one vehicle should be taken into the Paddock any others should be parked in the designated area. Consideration and space must be allowed for entrants arriving later. Entrants incorrectly parked will be instructed to move their vehicles. No vehicles should be parked on the grass.

#### **Engine/Noise Pollution**

All entrants should note that noise testing may be carried out at this event. Engines must not be run before 08:00 or after 18:00.

Any team member found in breach of these times shall at the entire discretion of MDA/Blyton Park, be removed immediately from the Venue and as such prevented from taking any further part in the Event.

#### Paddock

(a) Waste oil must be removed from the venue.

(b) All domestic rubbish must be placed in the bins provided, any scrap vehicle parts including tyres must be removed from the venue.

- (c) Under no circumstances must any paddock surface be broken in any way i.e. tent pegs/stakes etc.
- (d) There is a speed limit of 10mph on access, paddock roads and paddock areas.
- (e) Entrants are reminded that the warming up of cars on the perimeter track and other areas is prohibited.

## **Driver Briefing**

Drivers briefing will take place at 09:30 on the morning of Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> February 2023 in the Secretary's Office.

### Scrutineering

There will be no scrutineering of cars prior to going out on track, however, the organisers reserve the right to inspect any vehicle for safety/suitability. Any car deemed unsuitable will not be allowed out on track until it has been inspected and cleared by the officials. A scrutineer will be available for any enquires or queries.

### **Safety Requirements**

Drivers must present either their Motorsport UK Competition License or DVLA Road License at signing on. All junior drivers must present their Motorsport UK Competition License. Any persons under the age of 18 must also be signed on by their parent / guardian.

Helmets must be worn by drivers and passengers. Clothing which covers the arms and legs must be worn.

The organisers reserve the right to refuse access to the track to any driver / passenger who is not deemed to fit safely into the seat, or be wearing a safe fitting helmet.

## Passengers

Passengers can be booked on, on the day, at a cost of £20 per passenger for the day. This must be booked on the day and is payable in cash.

Passengers must wear a helmet and clothing which covers the arms and legs must be worn.

The passenger must be deemed to fit safely into the seat and be wearing a safe fitting helmet. The MDA reserve the right to refuse entry to the track if these conditions are met.
